SRF GREEN ALLEY BID SET 1 PROJECT

PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, FORM OF CONTRACT, AND ESTIMATED COST; SETTING DATE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, FORM OF CONTRACT, AND ESTIMATED COST; AND ORDERING THE ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBUQUE, IOWA:

The proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and estimated cost for the SRF Green Alley Bid Set 1 Project in the estimated amount \$411,547.00, are hereby preliminarily approved and ordered filed in the office of the City Clerk for public inspection.

A public hearing will be held on the 3rd day of February, 2014, at 6:30 p.m. in the Historic Federal Building Council Chambers at which time interested persons may appear and be heard for or against the proposed plans and specifications, form of contract and estimated cost of said Project, and the City Clerk be and is hereby directed to cause the attached notice of the time and place of such hearing to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Dubuque, Iowa, which notice shall be published not less than four days nor more than twenty days prior to the date of such hearing. At the hearing, any interested person may appear and file objections to the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract, or estimated cost of the Project.

The SRF Green Alley Bid Set 1 Project is hereby ordered to be advertised for bids for construction.

The amount of the security to accompany each bid shall be in an amount which shall conform to the provisions of the Notice to Bidders hereby approved.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to advertise for bids for the construction of the improvements herein provided, by publishing the attached Notice to Bidders to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Dubuque, Iowa, which notice shall be published not less than four but not more than forty-five days before the date for filing bids before 2:00 p.m. on the 6th day of February, 2014. Bids shall be opened and read by the City Clerk at said time and will be submitted to the City Council for final action at 6:30 p.m. on the 17th day of February, 2014, in the Historic Federal Building Council Chambers (second floor), 350 West 6th Street, Dubuque, Iowa.

SRF GREEN ALLEY BID SET 1 PROJECT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: The City Council of the City of Dubuque, Iowa will hold a public hearing on the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and estimated cost for the SRF Green Alley Bid Set 1 Project, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 26, Code of Iowa, at 6:30 p.m., on the 3rd day of February, 2014, in the Historic Federal Building Council Chambers (second floor), 350 West 6th Street, Dubuque, Iowa. Said proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and estimated cost are now on file in the office of the City Clerk. At said hearing any interested person may appear and file objections thereto.

The scope of the Project is as follows:

Reconstruction of the following alleys:

- Johnson Street to Windsor Avenue (Between Providence Street and Windsor Avenue)
- 14th Street to 15th Street (Between Cedar Street and Maple Street)
- Foye Street to Ellis Street (Between Almond Street and W. Locust Street)
 - Removal of the existing alley pavement
 - Excavation of the subgrade to allow the placement of clean washed stone for a storage medium
 - Installation of a concrete border for the brick pavers
 - Installation of HMA headers at the alley intersection with the intersecting streets.
 - Reconstruction of the pavement surface with interlocking concrete pavers
