

Art on the River

2010-2011 Sales Information

Art on the River is part of the Dubuque City Council's Arts and Culture initiative. Working in conjunction with the Arts and Cultural Affairs Advisory Commission, a volunteer committee, made up of artists, educators, a representative of the Dubuque Museum of Art, and city staff, have identified highly visible locations at the Port of Dubuque to display selected artwork.

This is a competitive exhibit and all of the works have been vetted by a jury of experts. Only ten are selected each year. The 2010-2011 exhibit drew 100 entries from artists in 18 different states, and one foreign country.

The jury reviews the artist applications and makes a recommendation to the Commission and to the City Council on the selection of artwork.

Featured artists receive a \$1,500 stipend for loaning their work for a year. All the pieces are for sale, but must stay in the exhibit through June 2011. The City functions as a gallery and will take a commission on each sale to fund future exhibitions. Sales price does not include delivery and installation of the sculpture at the buyer's site.

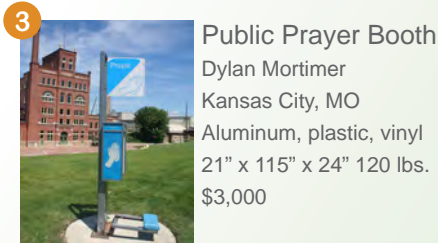

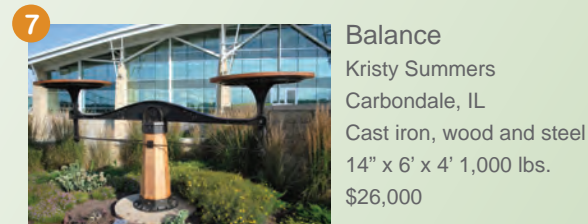

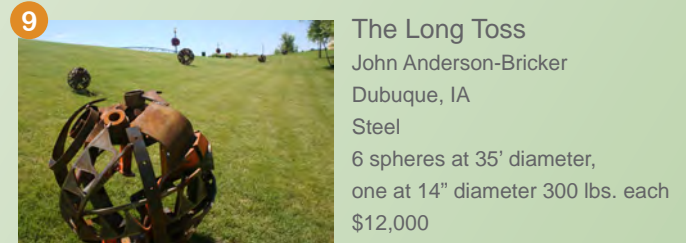
