
- Receive curbside collection reminders by email, phone, or text message.




Enabling Notifications


To enable notifications on an iOS device, go to Settings > Notifications and Allow Notifications. Customize how the notifications appear on your mobile device.

To enable notifications on an Android, go to Settings > Sound and notification > App notifications > Choose REThink Waste and allow notifications.


Customize the time and date of arrival for your collection day reminder.

Notifications on an iOS device





Waste Wizard

Regular, full-route yard debris and food scrap collection resumes on Monday, April 3

Current curbside yard waste container options are subscribed 64-gallon carts, 35-gallon cans with annual yard waste decals, 35-gallon cans with attached yellow stickers, or paper yard waste bags with attached yellow stickers.
