MILLER RIVERVIEW PARK
CAMPGROUND POLICIES

As a camper we ask you use the same good judgment required at other campgrounds and note the following policies; City park ordinances also apply to the campground:

1. Please stop at the campground manager's office next to the rest room/shower building to register and pay for your stay; you must be **eighteen years of age or older**. If no one is in the office and you have not made a reservation, check the information board for directions.
2. **RESERVATIONS / CHECK IN:** must check in by 7:00 p.m.; late arrangements should be made in advance by phoning (563) 589-4238.
3. **CHECK OUT** by 3:00 p.m. The campground manager can make exceptions.
4. **Rates per day are as follows:**
 - a. one tent / one vehicle \$10.00
 - b. one camper trailer / one vehicle \$12.00
 - c. one motor home / one tow vehicle \$12.00
 - d. one van, pickup or car \$12.00
 - e. one electrical hookup (site additional) \$ 3.00
 - f. non camper using dump site \$ 2.00
5. **VEHICLES.** By the time the gates are locked at 10:00 p.m., each camp site should have only ONE vehicle in the park, unless arrangements are made with the manager.
6. **LENGTH OF STAY:** *Camper(s) are limited to a stay no longer than fourteen (14) consecutive days. At the end of a fourteen-day stay, the camper(s) must leave for at least a five-day period. If the camper(s) return at the end of the five day period, they will be assigned a different campsite.*
7. Refunds are made through the Leisure Services Department office, Park Division Manager, for emergency situations only.
8. Park gates will open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 10:00 p.m. Only registered campers shall be permitted in the park at all other times (City ordinance Sec. 34-74). *Registered campers* who wish to return to the campground after 10:00 p.m. may obtain a gate key in advance from the campground manager; a \$5.00 deposit is required for the key.
9. The period from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. is quiet time in the campground. All campers should be set up in their campsites and noise level must not disturb their neighbors.

10. All pets must be confined in a camper or attended on a leash in the campground; **electronic leashes are not allowed.** When the pet is on a leash, the walker must have a pooper-scooper and clean up.
11. Recreational fires (campfires) must follow Dubuque Fire Department Policy, Code of Ordinances, Section 19.9:
 - a. burning limited to charcoal or growing form wood, dried, split or sawed, no greater than four feet in length
 - b. physical containment of the fire must be used (fire ring), and adequate separation from other combustibles and vegetation
 - c. no processed wood such as 2 x 4's, plywood, building materials, et cetera may be burned
 - d. fires are to be kept to a size with a flame height under five feet
 - e. atmosphere conditions should be such that allow for smoke and gases to rise up and away. If smoke and gases become a nuisance, the fire must be extinguished.
 - f. burning of papers, rubbish, refuse, grass, leaves or brush is prohibited; complaints will be directed to Fire Department through 911 dispatch.
12. All other park and recreation ordinances apply at the campground, when applicable.
13. Violation of park ordinances or campground policies can lead to immediate termination of camping permit.
14. Please report violations to the campground manager on site, or Dubuque Police/ Park Rangers, (563) 589-4415. **In case of emergency, dial 911.**
