WHEREAS, the City of Dubuque has established official Sister City relationships with three cities: Pyatigorsk, Russia; Handan, China; and Dornbirn, Austria; and

WHEREAS, the Sister City Relationships Committee of Travel Dubuque will present an exhibition that recognizes and promotes each city through photos, food samples and music; and
