## **Applications Now Available for City of Dubuque Arts and Cultural Grants for FY 2011**

DUBUQUE, Iowa – The City of Dubuque Arts and Cultural Affairs Advisory Commission is soliciting competitive applications from all interested parties for two distinct Arts and Culture funding programs for the FY 2011 grant cycle. Since 2005, the City of Dubuque has awarded over \$1,000,000 to area arts and culture organizations and other non-profits for programs that reach thousands of Dubuque adults and children each year.

Guidelines and applications for both the Operating Support Grants (due March 15, 2010) and Special Projects Grants (due May 11, 2010) are available as fillable forms at [www.cityofdubuque.org/grants](http://www.cityofdubuque.org/grants).

The Operating Support funding is designed to assist 501(c)(3) arts and culture organizations located in the City of Dubuque that primarily offer Dubuque residents with year-round arts and culture events, programming and services. Organizations must demonstrate a record of programmatic and administrative stability. There is \$200,000 available.

The Special Project finding is designed to encourage the development of new or expanded arts and cultural programs in the Dubuque community. Eligible applicants are Dubuque non-profit arts and culture organizations and other non-profits whose mission is consistent with the City's arts and culture goals. A total of \$35,000 is available, with a minimum request of \$2,500,
