Neighborhood Survey:

Subcommittee members Bob Kraye Dane Schrobiligen and Dirk Voetberg and five students from Rachel Daack's Clarke College class gathered at 10:00 a.m. at SMCC conference room and formed teams. The areas surveyed were portions of Ellis St.and Almond St.; 22 – 24 blocks of White St., and Rhomberg Ave. (Stafford to Ann St.). A total of 60 contacts were made resulting in 44 actual responses and 16 no door answers. The total of 77 previous responses and the 44 responses from today equals 121 responses. The previous 77 responses have already been recorded. Bob Kraye will input today's responses and have ready for Dirk Voetberg for reporting at the Safe Community Task Force meeting on Thursday, February 18 meeting. Today's survey ended this specific task. However there are still additional surveys to come from the schools and other sources to be included in the final analysis.

In the meantime subcommittee members are being contacted for scheduling a meeting within the next two weeks to begin the development process of analyzing the survey results; and discuss the future involvement of this committee. All subcommittee members are urged to be present.
