Applicants Sought for Safe Community Advisory Committee

DUBUQUE, Iowa – The City of Dubuque is seeking qualified applicants for the newly created, nine-member Safe Community Advisory Committee. Members would be appointed to a one-year term beginning in January 2011. Committee duties will include:

1. Monitor the implementation and progress of the Safe Community Task Force recommendations.
2. Serve as conduit for information to the City Manager.
3. Provide reports to the City Council as needed.
4. Research and tasks as assigned by the City Council.

The City Clerk's Office, located in City Hall at 50 West 13th Street, accepts applications for appointment to all boards and commissions. Applicants must reside within the Dubuque city limits. Completed applications for the Safe Community Advisory Committee should be submitted by Wednesday, December 1, and will be submitted to the City Council for their review at the December 6 City Council meeting. Applicants are notified and encouraged to attend that meeting to address the Council in support of their appointment to the Committee, which will be made at the December 20 City Council meeting. Applicants will then be notified of the outcome of the Council's action.
