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## **Public Workshop Scheduled for Downtown Design Guidelines**

DUBUQUE, Iowa – The City of Dubuque was awarded a State Historical Society of Iowa Certified Local Government Grant to develop design guidelines for the historic downtown area. Residents are invited to provide input on the guidelines at a public meeting on Tuesday, July 29.

The downtown design guidelines will be an important part of creating and maintaining the character of Downtown Dubuque. They will establish a consistent approach for the treatment of buildings, streetscapes, and landscapes within the historic downtown area.

Dubuque residents and downtown stakeholders are encouraged to participate in a hands-on workshop from 6 – 8 p.m. on Tuesday, July 29, in which the project will be introduced and feedback will be collected. The information gathered at this meeting will help further develop the design guidelines document. The meeting will be held in Meeting Rooms 1 and 2 at the Grand River Center, 500 Bell Street.
