July's 'Big View' Meeting Focuses on Integrity

DUBUQUE, Iowa –The public is invited to attend the Circles® Initiative Big View meeting, “Integrity,” at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 27, at The Holiday Inn, 450 Main St., Dubuque. A \$10 donation is suggested.

Gordon Graham, author of “The One-Eyed Man is King,” will share methods to build integrity and impact organizational and personal change as ways to combat poverty in Dubuque. Graham spent more than 17 years in prison and, upon release, was introduced to an education that helped him turn his life around. He decided then he wanted to get back into prisons to help people change who didn’t know how. He has developed several innovative DVD-based training curricula which are currently used across the U.S. and in Canada.

The meeting is offered as part of the monthly Big View series of meetings of the City of Dubuque’s Circles® initiative, a campaign to transform communities by building relationships that inspire and equip people to end poverty. Each month, a Big View meeting is held on a topic that invites the community to provide input and support to the systemic issues related to poverty.

Circles® is co-sponsored by the City of Dubuque’s Housing Department, DubuqueWorks, and Project HOPE, under a contract with the Community Foundation of Greater Dubuque.
