**Iowa Arts Council Grant-Writing Workshop
Rescheduled for March 10**

DUBUQUE, Iowa -- The City of Dubuque and the City's Arts and Cultural Affairs Advisory Commission are hosting an Iowa Arts Council Grant Writing Workshop. The event will be held on **Monday, March 10, 2008, 1 p.m. – 4 p.m., Bell Tower Theater, 2728 Asbury Road, Dubuque.** There will be an informal networking reception immediately following the workshop from 4-5:30 p.m. at the Fountain Park Event Center, 2728 Asbury Road. Both events are free and open to the public.

Grant program managers for the Iowa Arts Council and the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs will present information on what review panels expect to see in grant proposals. Learn about developing powerful grant proposals. Hear about the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs new E-grant system, new granting programs and changes to program guidelines. Participants can also sign up for a one-on-one meeting with Iowa Arts Council staff after the presentations to discuss projects in detail.
