City Expo 2008 Set for April 8

DUBUQUE, Iowa – The City of Dubuque will hold its annual City Expo on **Tuesday, April 8**, from 5-8 p.m. in the Five Flags Civic Center at 405 Main Street.

City Expo is designed to educate Dubuque residents about city programs, services, and resources. Through booths, displays, and demonstrations, City staff will provide information and answer questions residents may have. In recognition of Dubuque's 175th anniversary this year, and being named an All-America City last year, the theme of this year's Expo is **“City Expo 2008: An All-America City Celebrates 175 Years.”** Displays will reflect this theme through information, images, documents, equipment, and other objects that illustrate the history of the City's various departments and divisions. Additionally, City Expo will feature exhibits on some of the Envision 2010 Top 10 Ideas.

City Expo is a free, annual event that features activities and demonstrations designed for visitors of all ages. Dubuque residents are encouraged to bring their entire family. In an effort to reduce the use of plastic bags and support the City's sustainability efforts, people who plan to attend are encouraged to bring their own bag to collect informational and promotional materials which may be provided.
