## State of the City Address on March 25

DUBUQUE, Iowa – Dubuque Mayor Roy D. Buol will present the city’s seventh annual State of the City Address at 7 p.m. **Monday, March 25**, in the City Council Chambers of the Historic Federal Building, 350 W. Sixth St. The public is invited to attend.

The central theme of Buol’s address will be how Dubuque is “partnering for progress.” His remarks will highlight the impact of local higher education institutions, a review of major projects and initiatives underway and planned, Dubuque’s recent job growth record, existing business expansions, and the value of diversity.

“The City of Dubuque and its many partners are focused on setting the tone, serving the citizens, and creating the atmosphere to ensure Dubuque remains a place where citizens are enthusiastic about their community for the long term,” said Buol. “I look forward to this chance to highlight the projects and priorities to accommodate our current population but also make sure we are poised for the future.”
