Jule ‘Nightrider’ Evening Service Summer Hours

DUBUQUE, Iowa – The Jule, Dubuque’s public transit system, will continue its Nightrider fixed-route service on Friday and Saturday evenings throughout the summer with modified hours of operation.

This summer’s Nightrider hours of operation will be from 6 p.m. to 11 p.m. on Fridays and Saturdays from Friday, May 31, through Saturday, August 17.

The Nightrider route is open to the public and provides service every 30 minutes to west-end and downtown shopping, dining and entertainment venues. Complementary paratransit service (aka mini-bus service) is also available during the Nightrider hours of operation and must be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance.

The Nightrider route will resume its regular hours of 6 p.m. until 2:40 a.m. on Friday, August 23, 2013.

The Nightrider route is funded with an Iowa Clean Air Attainment Program (ICAAP) grant which was awarded by the Iowa Department of Transportation/Office of Public Transit. Clarke University, Loras College and University of Dubuque provide the local match needed to help fund this route. Their financial support allows college/university students free access to the Nightrider and all other Jule transit routes by showing their current school ID. This partnership with the local colleges and universities will continue throughout the summer.
