Thursday Night Lane Closures Planned for U.S. 52/61/151

DUBUQUE, Iowa – The Iowa Department of Transportation reports that the placement of five large bridge girders will require lane closures on U.S. 52/61/151 this Thursday night, Aug. 22.

The nighttime work will require intermittent traffic stoppages on both the northbound and southbound lanes of US 52/61/151 starting at 10 p.m. on Thursday. Flaggers will be in-place and motorists are encouraged to use caution in the area of temporary traffic control. Placement of the bridge girders is expected to be completed by 6 a.m. on Friday.

This Iowa DOT project includes reconstruction of U.S. 52/61/151 from the Grandview interchange to the U.S. 52 intersection, the replacement of both existing bridges spanning Catfish Creek, installation of a median barrier, and improvements at the U.S. 52 intersection with U.S. 61/151.
