Dubuque’s City Expo Set for Sept. 10

DUBUQUE, Iowa – The 2013 version of the City of Dubuque's City Expo event will be held on Tuesday, Sept. 10, and will feature new hours, 10 seminars, a revised layout, and a new approach to the annual event.

City Expo will be held from 4 – 7 p.m. at the Five Flags Civic Center at 405 Main Street. As always, the event is free and all Dubuque residents are invited to attend to learn about City services and programs. City Expo will offer booths from 26 City departments and divisions, 12 partner agencies and organizations, as well as large equipment displays on Fifth Street, between Locust and Main streets, weather permitting. Informational materials and complimentary refreshments will be available.

This year’s Expo will also offer 10 different 30-minute seminars on a variety of City services, projects and programs. Two seminars will be held simultaneously on mini-stages in the Five Flags arena. The seminar schedule is as follows:

Additionally, the Leisure Services Department will offer golf swing clinics, hosted by Bunker Hill Golf Course Pro George Stephenson, at 4:15, 5:15, and 6:15 p.m.

Expo attendees will also have the opportunity to win a new iPad if they participate in an “Expo Passport” activity. By taking their passport form (provided at the event) to every City department and division booth, asking a question and having the passport signed by a City staff member, and submitting their passport to the public information office booth, they will be eligible to win an iPad. Participants need not be present to win. The winner will be announced at 7 p.m. that evening.
