## **Jule Bus Passes Now Sold at City Hall**

DUBUQUE, Iowa – Bus passes for The Jule’s public transit services can now be purchased at City Hall. Additional locations are expected to be announced in coming months as efforts continue to transform the system, better serve current passengers, and attract new passengers.

Passes may be purchased by cash, check, or credit/debit card at the City Treasurer’s window on the first floor of City Hall at 50 West 13<sup>th</sup> Street. Three types of passes are offered: half fare passes (10 rides for \$5), adult passes (10 rides for \$9), and monthly passes (\$35 for unlimited rides, prorated and effective for the calendar month). Para-transit (mini-bus) passes are also available at \$10 for 10 rides. Passes can also be purchased by cash or check only at The Jule Office at 2401 Central Ave.

Fixed route passes only are available for cash purchase at Dubuque Bank & Trust at 1398 Central Ave., American Trust & Savings Bank at 895 Main St., Premier Bank at 1975 John F. Kenney Rd., and Dupaco Community Credit Union branches at 1467 Sycamore St., 3299 Hillcrest Rd., and 400 S. Locust St.
