## **New Jule Routes to Begin January 2014**

DUBUQUE, Iowa – The Jule, the City of Dubuque’s public transit system, will launch an improved route structure January 6, 2014. Routes and schedules effective January 6, 2014 are now available online at:  
[www.cityofdubuque.org/NewRoutes](http://www.cityofdubuque.org/NewRoutes).

The new cross town express and looped service will offer faster bus transportation between downtown and the west end as well as new service areas, increased service for some areas, trip times shortened by up to 50% and extended service hours from downtown to west side locations Monday through Friday.

Two new routes have been created:

- 1) The Express is a 15-minute non-stop express service between the 6th & Iowa Street (downtown) and John F. Kennedy Circle (west end) transfer locations.
- 2) The newly configured Grey Line is divided into 15-minute service between the 6th & Iowa Street and Delhi Street transfers, and 15-minute service between the Delhi Street and John F. Kennedy Circle transfer locations, with stops at popular locations.
