## **“Feeders Along the Flyway” Airs Christmas Day at 1 p.m.**

DUBUQUE, Iowa – CityChannel Dubuque invites local cable subscribers to turn their televisions into a window to the backyard birdfeeder in "Feeders Along the Flyway," Christmas Day at 1 p.m. on the City's government access cable channel (analog channel 8 or digital 85.2).

"Feeders Along the Flyway" presents more than three and a half hours of tri-state birdfeeder activity. "The Mississippi River is a major migratory route," says Craig Nowack, Cable TV Coordinator for the City of Dubuque. "This is an excellent part of the country for birdwatching." Nowack and Video Producer Erich Moeller recorded birdfeeder activity throughout 2013. Among the locations where feeders were recorded are Four Mounds Inn & Conference Center, the Mines of Spain, Swiss Valley Nature Center, and several private residences.

Viewers will see more than 20 species of birds, including hummingbirds, finches, orioles, woodpeckers, cardinals, and sparrows. The soundtrack is scored by the birds themselves as the audio is the natural sound recorded with the video.

"Feeders Along the Flyway" will be repeated on New Year's Day at 9 a.m. Like all CityChannel Dubuque programs, it will also be streamed live and archived on the City's website at [www.cityofdubuque.org/media](http://www.cityofdubuque.org/media).
