14th Street Railroad Crossing Reconstruction Begins Monday

DUBUQUE, Iowa – Repairs to the 14th Street railroad crossing between Elm and Maple streets will begin on Monday and will require the closure of the crossing and a portion of 14th Street for approximately two weeks.

The 14th Street Railroad Grade Crossing Reconstruction Project is a partnership between the City of Dubuque, Canadian Pacific Railway, and the Iowa Department of Transportation. The project will involve the complete reconstruction of the railroad grade crossing as well as the approach roadway pavement on both sides of the rail line.

The street closure will begin at 7 a.m. on Monday, June 16, and is anticipated to require approximately 14 working days to complete, weather conditions permitting. Alternate detour routes will be established to minimize the impacts of the street/railroad crossing closure. Access to businesses and properties on 14th Street will be maintained throughout the closure.
