Keyline Transit to hold public input meetings

DUBUQUE, Iowa – The City of Dubuque’s Keyline Transit Service will hold two public meetings next week to offer information and solicit public input regarding public transit needs in Dubuque.

The first meeting will be held on **Tuesday, Feb. 17**, from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. The second meeting will be held on **Wednesday, Feb. 18**, from 11:00 a.m. to 1 p.m. Both meetings will be held in the Majestic Room on the second floor of the Five Flags Civic Center at 405 Main Street. Similar information will be presented at both meetings so interested persons need not attend both.

According to Keyline Transit Manager Jon Rodocker, the two meetings are part of Keyline Transit’s comprehensive operational analysis. “The purpose of these meetings is to offer the public an opportunity to give us their suggestions for the mini-buses and fixed route buses,” said Rodocker. “We also plan to discuss route design, operating times, days of operations, and opportunities for service expansion.”
