## **Registration Deadline Extended to Monday for ‘Growing Sustainable Communities’ Conference**

DUBUQUE, Iowa – The registration deadline for Dubuque’s second annual “Growing Sustainable Communities” conference has been extended to Monday, Feb. 16. The public is invited to attend the event which will be held on Thursday, Feb. 19, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Grand River Center. Cost to attend is \$20 per person, which includes lunch. The conference is being sponsored by the City of Dubuque and Alliant Energy.

The theme of this year’s conference is “Promoting Historic Preservation as Part of the Climate Solution” and will offer insight on creating local and regional policies to promote sustainability through historic preservation. Keynote speakers for the event are Richard Moe, president of the National Trust for Historic Preservation, and Roya Stanley, director of the Iowa Office for Energy Independence. In addition to their individual presentations, both will participate in a question and answer panel discussion.
