Walking Tour of the Bee Branch Creek Restoration Project**

Civil Engineers Deron Muehring and Steve Brown conducted a walking tour of the Bee Branch Creek Restoration Project starting from 420 Garfield Avenue to 24th Street. Highlights included descriptions of construction progress and associated elements; stormwater management/conveyance components; land acquisitions; infrastructure upgrades to surrounding neighborhoods and project amenities such as bike paths, amphitheater, orchard, fishing, landscaping, plant materials, bridge designs, safety features and pedestrian and vehicular access. Citizen input and outreach programs to surrounding schools regarding safety measures were also highlighted.
