## Imagine Dubuque Equity Community Workshop

DUBUQUE, Iowa – Dubuque residents and stakeholders are invited to participate in the “Imagine Dubuque Equity Community Workshop” on Tuesday, June 27, from 6–8 p.m. at Prescott Elementary School, 1151 White St. The Equity Community Workshop is co-hosted by the City of Dubuque, Circles Initiative, and Inclusive Dubuque. The Equity Community Workshop is the fourth and final in a series of interactive public workshops focused on gathering and refining input as part of the City of Dubuque’s comprehensive planning process, entitled “Imagine Dubuque.”

Imagine Dubuque is the community’s plan for our future. It is the next step in creating a more sustainable, resilient, inclusive, and equitable legacy for Dubuque. The Comprehensive Plan serves as a guide for the community’s physical, social and economic development and is a key tool for developing policy, informing the city budget, and community initiatives. Imagine Dubuque is designed to further Dubuque’s momentum toward creating a more viable, livable, and equitable community.

At the Equity Community Workshop, the community will take part in collaborative feedback activities and interactive idea building.
