## **Public Input Sought on Millwork District Redevelopment**

DUBUQUE, Iowa – The City of Dubuque’s Engineering Department and its consultants will conduct an open house on Tuesday, August 25, from 6:00 p.m.-7:30 p.m. at 120 E. 9th Street, (the former Phoenix Fitness) to gain input from property and business owners and residents in and around the Historic Millwork District about the area’s redevelopment. There will be a short presentation beginning at 6:20 p.m.

The Historic Millwork District project will include replacement of water main, valves and services, replacement of storm sewer and inclusion of sustainable treatments, possible replacement of sanitary sewer and services, street and sidewalk construction and reconstruction along with streetscape elements within the public right-of-way. The open house seeks to provide information to citizens about the schedule and the steps that will be taken next for development of these improvements. The public is invited to attend the event to provide input on what amenities could be included in the redevelopment of the area as well as what types of land uses could be included.

Phasing and staging of the projects are not yet determined nor are all the funding sources needed to accomplish the improvements for the entire district. Applications for grants are being prepared.
