1. Health Services: Mary Rose Corrigan, Public Health Specialist;
2. Human Rights Department: Kelly Larson, Human Rights Director; Collins Eboh, Organizational Equity Coordinator; and Temwa Phiri, Community Engagement Coordinator;
3. Carnegie-Stout Public Library: Susan Henricks, Library Director;
4. Dubuque Regional Airport: Todd Dalsing, Airport Director;
5. Finance & Budget Department: Jenny Larson, Director of Finance and Budget.

The presenters responded to questions from the City Council following their respective presentations.

Following the Human Rights Department presentation, Human Rights Commission Member Jerry Hamel requested that funding for the Race in the Heartland conference be added to the department's budget request as it was inadvertently left out. The City Council reached consensus on reconsidering the funding request at the final budget hearing on March 26, 2020.
