

RESOLUTION NO. -14

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE CITY MANAGER AS AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE REGARDING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE'S ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION AND THE CITY OF DUBUQUE, IOWA FOR THE UPPER BEE BRANCH CREEK RESTORATION.

Whereas, a Federal Disaster Declaration was issued on August 30, 2011 for Dubuque County due to flash flooding following rainfall totaling nearly fourteen inches in a ten hour period;

Whereas, the U.S. Economic Development Administration (EDA) announced the availability of disaster mitigation funding for cities and counties that received a Federal Disaster Declaration in 2011;

Whereas, the City of Dubuque submitted an application for funding to the EDA for the Upper Bee Branch Creek Disaster Resiliency Project;

Whereas, the EDA approved the City's application for the Upper Bee Branch Creek Disaster Resiliency Project on August 8th, 2013 in the amount of \$1,227,138; and

Whereas, the City of Dubuque executed an agreement with the EDA on August 19, 2013.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBUQUE, IOWA, THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to act as an authorized representative on the Economic Development Administration grant agreement and may execute any documents required by the agreement as the Economic Development Administration may reasonably request.
