On-Street Accessible Parking Space Request

The City of Dubuque may provide an accessible parking space sign to residents with a disability to aid in their transportation and mobility. For those residents who meet the following two criteria, the Transportation Services Department will consider an application for a restricted space:

1. The resident has a current State of Iowa issued disability parking permit
2. The resident has no accessible off-street parking available

If the resident meets both qualifications, complete the following form to begin the review process:

Placement of a parking space in a location does not guarantee permanent or lifetime use of that parking space for the approved applicant. Placement of an accessible parking space at a location does not imply reserved parking for the person who requested the space or for any other individual. An on-street accessible parking space can be used at any time by anyone whose vehicle displays the appropriate State-issued placard or license plate.
