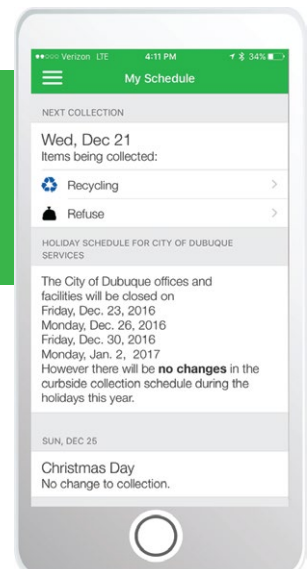
- Receive curbside collection reminders by email, phone, or text message.

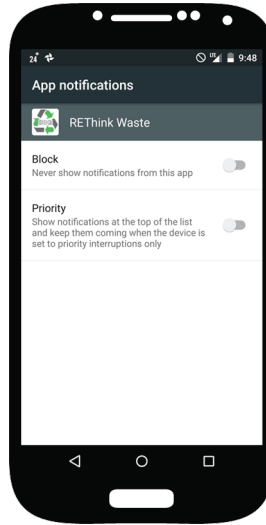


## Enabling Notifications

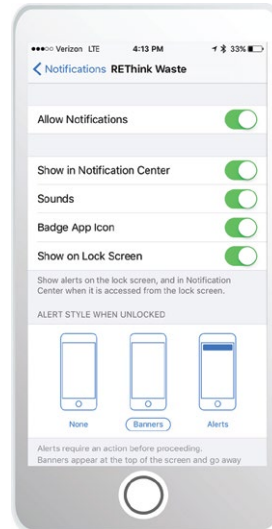
To enable notifications on an iOS device, go to Settings > Notifications and Allow Notifications. Customize how the notifications appear on your mobile device.

To enable notifications on an Android, go to Settings > Sound and notification > App notifications > Choose RETHink Waste and allow notifications.

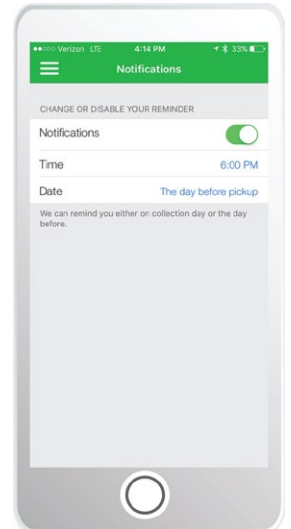
Customize the time and date of arrival for your collection day reminder.



Notifications on an Android

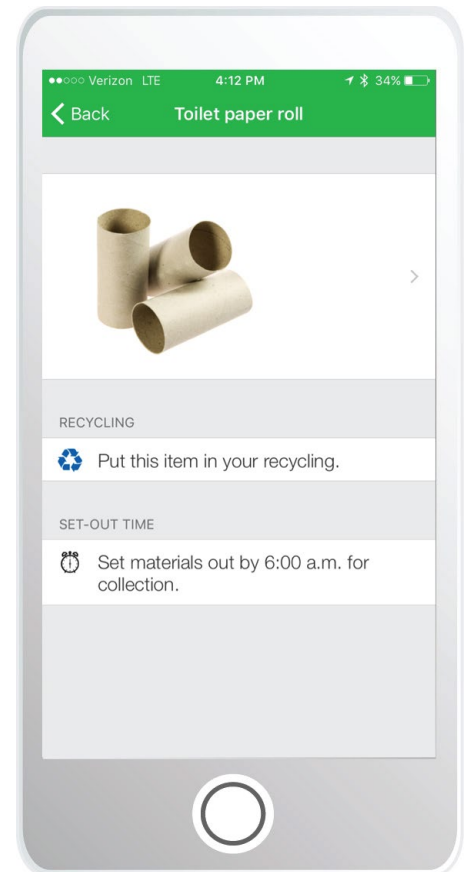
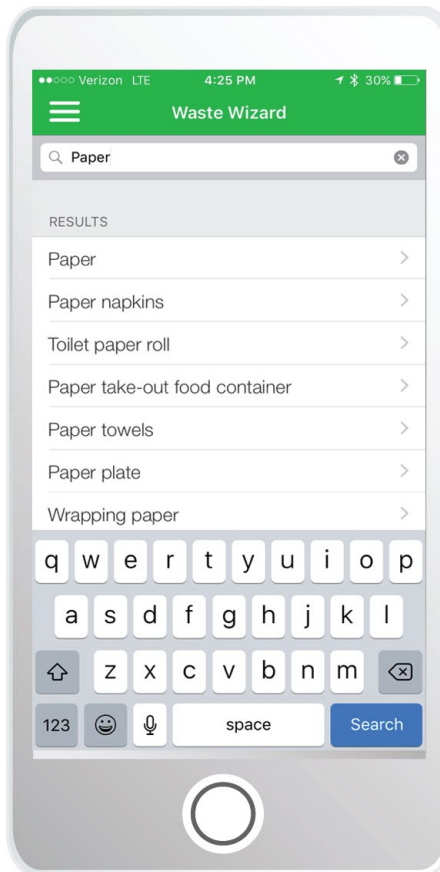


Notifications on an iOS device

Current curbside yard waste container options are subscribed 64-gallon carts, 35-gallon cans with annual yard waste decals, 35-gallon cans with attached yellow stickers, or paper yard waste bags with attached yellow stickers.
