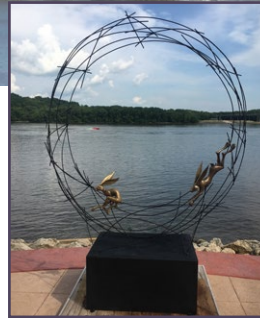
- Sculpture is a great addition to your business, makes a wonderful donation to your favorite nonprofit, or embellishes your own yard.
