Project Manager Steve Sampson Brown recommends City Council approval to distribute a Request for Qualifications for engineering services related to managing the Environmental Protection Agency's Brownfield Clean Up Grant for the West Blum Brownfield Clean Up Project. The RFQ will also provide for City-wide environmental engineering on-call professional services for a term of three to five years related to: capital improvement projects, environmental site assessments in support of property acquisitions, contaminated soil and groundwater management, environmental health and safety planning, hazardous materials emergency response, and site specific hazardous materials handling education for City staff and contractors. It is further recommended that the City Manager be authorized to negotiate an agreement with the recommended consultant.
