NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: The City Council of the City of Dubuque, Iowa will hold a public hearing in the Historic Federal Building, Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, 350 West 6th Street, Dubuque, Iowa at 6:00 p.m. on April 2, 2018 on the status of funded activities associated with funding contract #13-NDRI-011 for Community Development Block Grant, National Disaster Resilience Infrastructure Grant funding.

The scope of the improvements outlined in contract #13-NDRI-011 are as follows:

- Bee Branch Railroad Culvert Infrastructure Improvements involving the installation of culverts through Canadian Pacific Railway property at 506 Garfield Avenue;

- 22nd Street/Kaufmann Avenue Storm Sewer Improvements involving the installation of a large diameter storm sewer from 22nd & Elm Streets up Kaufmann Avenue to the Kaufmann Avenue & Kane Street intersection. The work includes inlets and local sewer connections to the storm sewer and the complete reconstruction of the street and other underground utilities along street right-of-way corridor.

- 17th Street/W. Locust Street Storm Sewer Improvements involving the installation of a 96-inch diameter pipe from the Lower Bee Branch Creek through the Canadian Pacific Railway tracks to 17th Street then to the west along 17th Street and finally west along W. Locust Street towards Rosedale Avenue. The work includes inlets and local sewer connections to the storm sewer and the complete reconstruction of the street and other underground utilities along street right-of-way corridor.

Written comments regarding the above public hearings may be submitted to the City Clerk's Office on or before said time of public hearing. At said time and place of public hearings, all interested citizens and parties will be given an opportunity to be heard for or against said proposal.
