On February 26, 2019, the City received bids for the 22nd Street/Kaufmann Avenue Storm Sewer Improvements Project (White Street to Kleine Street). Bidders were asked to provide two options, one that includes construction from White Street to Francis Street and another from White Street to Kleine Street. In the bidding documents, the City outlined that award of the contract would be based on the lowest bid, awarding the option based on the available funding.

Due to the availability of funding for this project, City Engineer Gus Psihoyos recommends award of the construction contract for Option A (White Street to Kleine Street) to the low bidder, Portzen Construction, in the amount of \$2,349,054.47, which is 20.54% under the estimate of probable cost. The improvements will be mostly funded using a portion of the \$23.1 million Community Development Block Grant Program Disaster Recovery-National Disaster Resiliency funds.

I concur with the recommendation and respectfully request Mayor and City Council approval.
