

The mission of the budget process is to help decision makers make informed choices for the provision of services and capital assets and to promote stakeholder participation in the decision process.




Where Does the Money Come From?

Where Do Your Property Taxes Go?


Property Tax Split (FY2018 –FY2019)


FY2020 Versus FY2019


Dubuque has the SECOND LOWEST property tax rate as compared to the eleven largest cities in the state. The highest rate (Council Bluffs) is 76.77% higher than Dubuque's rate, and the average is 47.11% higher than Dubuque.


Retired Debt Versus New Debt (in millions)



* Five-Year Average of New Debt FY16-FY20 \$10,800,907





FY20 Wage Increase

- 1.5% Wage Increase for Bargaining Units and General Employee Wage Plan

City of Dubuque Fiscal Year 2020 Budget

Parental Leave – Effective 3/8/19

- Applies to Full-Time Non-Bargaining Unit Employees
- Paid Time Away for Birth or Adoption of Child Under 18 Years Old
- 12 Weeks regular pay + benefits
- If both parents are eligible employees, each will receive the benefit
- Must be used within 12 months following birth or adoption
- Can be taken intermittently
- Must be tracked by Departments (similar to family sick leave)

City of Dubuque Fiscal Year 2020 Budget

50% Sick Leave – Effective 7/1/19

- Applies to Full-Time Non-Bargaining Unit Employees
- Employees Over Sick Leave Cap – Computed Each Pay Period
- Convert 50% of Sick Leave Over Cap to Vacation or Paid Out
- Method Determined by Department Manager
- Must Be Tracked at Department Level
- Finance Will Provide Recurring Monthly Reports/Template for Departments to determine payout/accrual
