




Mop Sink Backflow Prevention

What is backflow?


Backflow is the potentially dangerous reversal of the flow of solid, liquid or gas from its intended direction in any pipe or plumbing system.

What's required?

A plumbing system must be protected from backflow at each point of use in the food establishment, including at a mop sink (Southern Nevada Health District Food Regulations, 5-203.4).



An Atmospheric Vacuum Breaker (AVB) must be used when connecting a hose to a two-way splitter installed on a mop sink.



- Do not install an AVB between the mop sink and a two-way splitter.
- Do not use a hand sprayer on a hose connected to a two-way splitter with an AVB installed.
